

LUNDY QUAD WARDROBE Assembly for wardrobes up until late 2020

Over the last 12-18 months our Lundy Quad has outsourced the manufacture of the Lundy range and the quad wardrobe is now completely flat-pack for ease of shipping (however they are way harder to put together!)

Here are basic instructions for dismantling and re-building the Quad up-to 2020 – print and follow them carefully it has basically 6 components screwed together in fairly logical places...

1. Remove loose hanging rails and drawers.
2. Unscrew cornice moulding & remove - screws can be found either in the inside top corners and top front or they will be fitted externally from the top down - found in the recess of the cornice in plain wooden blocks.
3. Unscrew plinth moulding - screws are found inside the robe, bottom corners and 2x in the front frame underneath the bottom drawer that has been removed.
4. Unscrew single sections of wardrobe & remove - screws found inside panel of each single section, normally about 8x in each.
5. Split single section - screws can be found in the following areas... 2x underneath the door section at the front, found by looking up underneath where the top drawer has been removed. 2x or 4x in corners of the double door section.
6. Remove 2 door section
7. Remove drawer base.
8. All that should be left is the loose plinth.

Reverse for assembly
